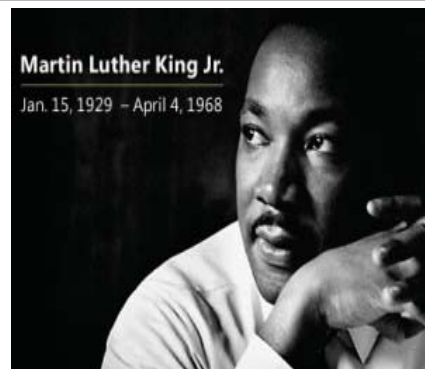
Today is our monthly Food Drive This food drive helps OLG parishioners in 30 households in need, focusing especially on children, senior citizens. Please

Spirit & Song Hymnals

A big heartfelt thank you to all those who contributed for our new hymnal! Our pews have sure been looking beautiful since the holiday season began in December. The new ***Spirit & Song*** looks so nice sitting next to the new edition of the ***Flory Canto*** that came in last year. It's as if OCP coordinated the colors on purpose! We are hoping to enjoy our beautiful hymnals for years to come and may they be a welcoming sign to all who visit our parish. Now, it is up to all of us to keep them neat and tidy each week by always placing them back into the pew bins after each mass so they're ready to go and easy to find for the next mass.

More good news! We actually ended up raising a little extra money and were able to purchase some necessary items to maintain our music equipment ~ a cart for the multitude of music stands that are used every week and one wireless microphone system. Our plan is to gradually replace our current wired microphones for the newer technology wireless systems. We do our best to keep the music space free of wires which pose the risk of someone tripping and falling. Marty painstakingly tapes down loose wires week after week and sets up the music space as neat as possible which is not only an esthetic practice, but is called for by the General Instruction of the Roman Missal (GIRM). The wireless microphones would eliminate about 80% of the wires. Each wireless microphone system costs just over \$600 and we are looking to purchase 9 more in the future to replace the current microphones. Those who wish to make a (tax-deductible) contribution in the immediate or near future, may make a donation marked for the "Music Ministry" and we will know that it is intended for this purpose. 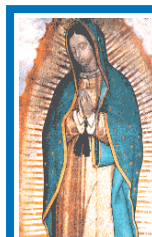
