Several people have asked me if I am excited about my move to Scotland. I am but there are many things to take care of first. I have really enjoyed OLG, so I'm in no hurry to leave. There is still much to do. I'm still waiting for my Visa to be approved and arrive. Having been a missionary, I have travels, Visas and residencies in Countries that they need to look at, so it is taking longer. I am still planning my last Sunday at OLG to be August 3rd. I'm planning to go visit my family in Toledo, OH and then be in Aberdeen Sept. 1. As I leave the parish, I have a favor to ask of you. I'm moving to Scotland and will be the Guardian of our first Friary in Scotland in 500 years. I will be taking only what I need (hopefully 2 bags). When I get to Aberdeen there will be a need to ready our Friary for three Friars. In the past, the Campus Ministry was staffed by one priest. There will be "things" that we will need for three of us to live together. So if anyone would like to help me to do whatever will be necessary, it would be helpful. Among the things that we will have to figure out is some form of transportation for the Friary – bikes, car or whatever, beds, chairs etc. So to be clear – please do not give me any gifts. If you want to write something to me, a note or a letter, this would mean much. If you want to do something financial, it would be helpful. For a charitable gift for your taxes, please use the title Conventual Franciscans on any checks. My Provincial gave me permission to do this. Thank You for all your acts of kindness!! Happy Father's Day to all the Fathers!! Enjoy the day!! May God bless you as you live your fatherhood. Pray for your father today, and please pray for all fathers today. It is through their loving care that we have gained insight into the mystery of God and the gift of life that we have received through them. May we be blessed through them.

Today is the beginning for our Father's Day Novena. It is still not too late to enroll your Father either living or deceased.

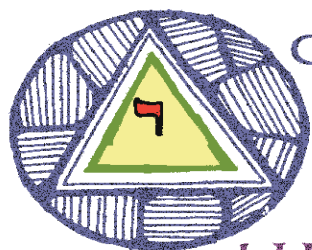
Cards are available at the back of the church or at the parish office. The Novena list will be placed on the Altar to be prayed for, for nine days.

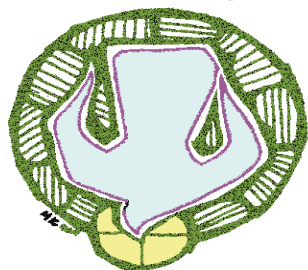

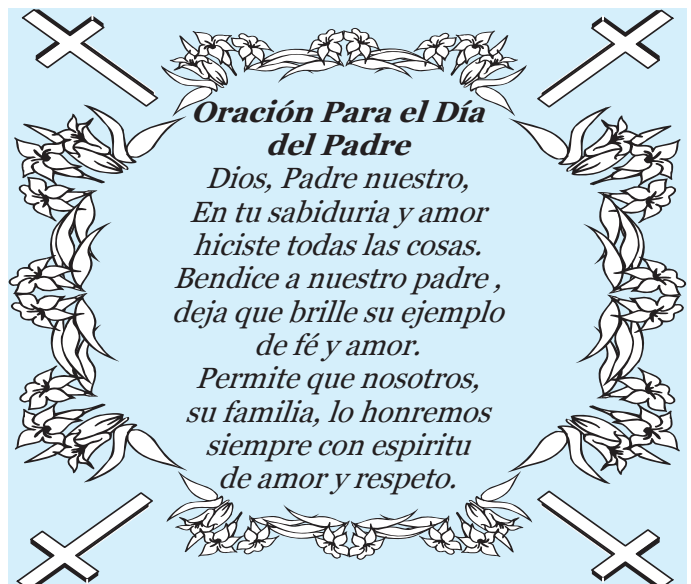

Por lo regular, un niño le dice a su padre o madre si ella o él no quiere que alguien en la/lo abrace o bese. ¡Enseñe a los padres a escuchar a sus hijos y a respetar sus deseos! Insista con los adolescentes sobre la importancia de la "seguridad corporal total" en sus relaciones con los demás. Dígales, "Sólo porque una persona es una amistad cercana o aun un amigo o amiga, eso no les da derecho para tocarte en una forma que te haga sentir incómodo". Al enseñar "seguridad corporal total" a adultos, niños y a jóvenes, estamos avanzando en nuestros esfuerzos para detener el abuso sexual infantil y hacer del mundo un lugar más seguro para todos los hijos de Dios. 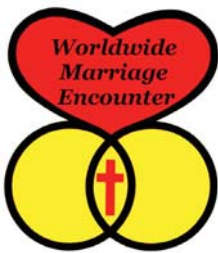
