A Few Thoughts from Fr. Ray

◆ Next Weekend is my last weekend in the Parish. During the remainder of August I'll be with my family and then fly to Aberdeen to join the friars to begin Campus Ministry at the University of Aberdeen and open the Duns Scotus Friary. Bl. Duns Scotus was a 13th Century Franciscan Theologian and he was born in Scotland. The opening of this Friary represents to the Friars the return of Conventual Franciscan Friary life to Scotland.

For those who may have missed this – about a year and half ago, I volunteered to return to the Missions. Campus Ministry became the Mission because Bishop Hugh (the Bishop of Aberdeen) invited the friars to come and live as a Community of Friars and care for the University of Aberdeen.

Personally, being your Pastor for the last eight years has been a major blessing. I learned much about Faith, Hope and Charity through you. While I have been busy Pastoring you, you have Pastored me. I am a better Priest and Religious because of you. You have readied me for my next ministry.

I firmly believe, life only gets better for those who believe and are open to the will of God - that belief includes OLG. Both Fr. Lazaro and I brought gifts and talents to OLG. Your new Pastor and Associate will also bring their gifts and talents. Once again OLG will be blessed and enriched. I know who is coming and they will do things in ways that I cannot do. During the "*not so good times*", some tragedies touched our good families as the economy collapsed, and some illnesses visited us. We prayed hard for healing and for some, God gave the blessing to be healed.

I go away confident in my new assignment knowing that I have the support and prayers of an entire community. I have been assigned to St. Paul Catholic Church in San Pablo, California Diocese of Oakland. My last weekend at the Our Lady of Guadalupe will be August 30-31. Thanks to all for your prayers, love, and kindness. May the grace of the Lord Christ be with you always. Amen.

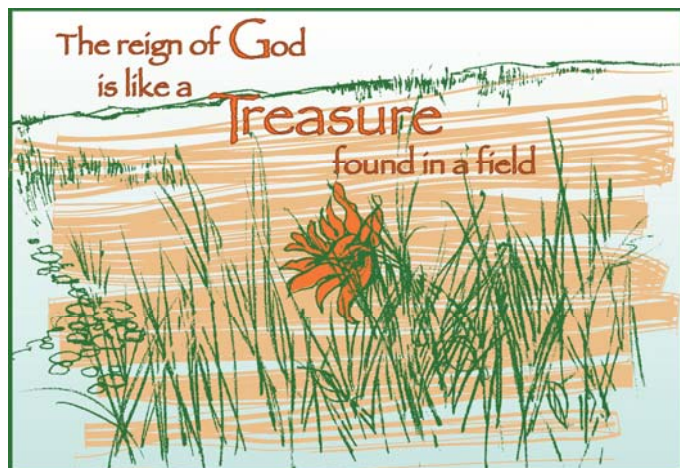

in Torrance. The hours of operation are Monday—Friday 9AM—2PM



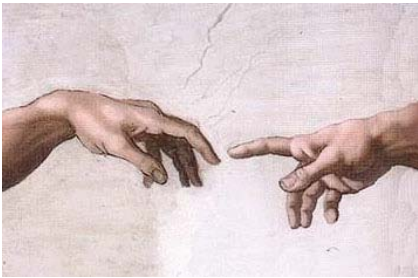

No one is ordained unless the staff of St. John's Seminary, including the lay faculty and formation advisers, concludes that the candidate has attained an emotional, psychological and sexual maturity appropriate for his age and for the celibate life of a priest.
