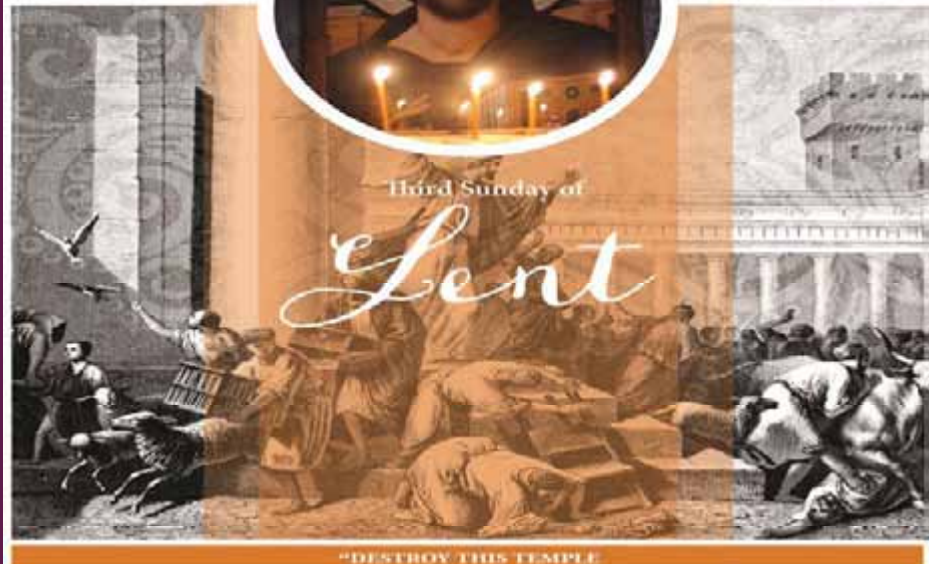

EL CULTO A DIOS.

No tendrás otros dioses frente a mí. Estas palabras que el Señor dice a su pueblo también nos las dice hoy a nosotros. Los diosillos del mercado económico no deben ser nunca los dioses que dirijan nuestra vida. Nuestro único Dios es el Dios que se nos manifestó en la persona de Jesús de Nazaret y debemos dirigir nuestra vida con los valores de su evangelio. Esta es la nueva y eterna alianza que Dios ha querido hacer con nosotros, rociada y confirmada con la sangre del Cordero.

Lo débil de Dios es más fuerte que los hombres. Lo "débil de Dios" se refiere a Cristo crucificado, escándalo para los judíos, necedad para los griegos. Hacer de la cruz y el sufrimiento fuerza y sabiduría de Dios es hoy día para muchos contemporáneos nuestros, escándalo y necedad. Pero los cristianos sabemos que la cruz y el sufrimiento no son para nosotros un fin buscado, sino un medio aceptado para salvarnos nosotros y para ayudar a otros a llegar hasta Dios. Por nuestra débil y pecadora condición humana, la cruz y el sufrimiento los vamos a tener siempre con nosotros; lo importante es que esa cruz y ese sufrimiento no nos hundan y nos maten, sino que nos levanten y resuciten. Así nos lo enseñó nuestro Señor Jesucristo, haciendo del madero de la cruz árbol de salvación.

Jesús relativiza la importancia del templo como "lugar de culto", señalando que la cuestión no es si en Jerusalén o en Garizín, sino en el corazón y en la actitud que tenemos cuando damos culto a Dios. Ya en el Antiguo Testamento Dios había dicho que quería misericordia y no sacrificios. Por eso se atreve Jesús a decir que era capaz de destruir el Templo y levantarlo en tres días. Hablar así para los judíos ortodoxos era una blasfemia. Pero El se refería al templo de su cuerpo, que iba a morir y resucitar. Es un anticipo de la Pascua ya cercana, pues Jesús había tomado ya la decisión de "subir a Jerusalén", donde estaba el centro de la religión judía. Reflexionemos sobre nuestra forma personal de vivir la "religación con Dios" y veamos si son adecuados los servicios religiosos que prestamos. Lo cultural es necesario, pero una parroquia o cualquier comunidad cristiana debe ejercer también el ministerio -servicio- del anuncio gozoso del Evangelio -catequesis- y del amor gratuito a los necesitados -caridad-. ¡Pobres cristianos seríamos si nos quedamos sólo en lo cultural!. Por eso estamos invitados a eso desde el Evangelio.

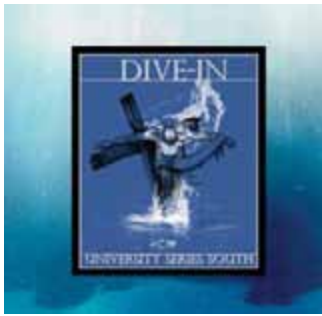
