**.- LA JUSTICIA SOCIAL, PRIMER MANDAMIENTO DEL BAUTISTA**

.- La gente preguntaba a Juan: entonces, ¿qué debemos hacer? Cuando uno acaba de leer este texto del evangelio según san Lucas, lo primero que se le viene a uno a la cabeza es: ¡qué necesitados estamos de predicadores como Juan el Bautista! En estos tiempos de crisis económica, de falta de la paz, del irrespeto por la vida y de tantas cosas, necesitaríamos a predicadores que, con el prestigio social y moral que tenía el Bautista, se atrevieran a decir públicamente que lo primero que tenemos que hacer para salir de la crisis es convertirnos al evangelio, empezando por repartir y compartir con los necesitados todo lo que nosotros no necesitamos. Aunque, claro, quizá lo más urgente sea convencer a la gente para que se atreva a preguntar a Juan el Bautista qué debe hacer para salir de la crisis. Porque, si preguntamos a los políticos, ya sabemos lo que nos van a decir. Pero lo que nos dicen los políticos no nos lo acabamos de creer y las soluciones que nos piden los que dirigen la economía nos molestan mucho y nos consuelan poco. La solución que da el Bautista a los tres grupos de gente que se acercaron a preguntarle fue, sustancialmente, la misma: justicia social y paz. Que al que le sobra ropa, y comida, la reparta con el que no tiene; que los encargados de poner impuestos e imponer recortes exijan más al que tiene más, exijan menos al que tiene menos y no exijan nada al que nada tiene; y que los que tienen cargos con autoridad no sean corruptos y se conformen con el buen sueldo que ya perciben. En definitiva: justicia social, justicia social y justicia social, y por ende esto trae la paz, porque cuando la gente vive en justicia social todo lo demás viene bien. Como primer mandamiento para salir de esta crisis que muchos están padeciendo injustamente. ¿Nos atreveremos nosotros a preguntar al Bautista y a llevar a la práctica las soluciones que él nos dé? Sería maravilloso.

Jesús no vino a condenarnos, sino a redimirnos y a salvarnos; esta certeza es la que nos llena de alegría, porque no se basa en la eficacia de nuestros méritos, sino en el amor generoso y gratuito de Dios. Las palabras del profeta Sofonías son muy claras y consoladoras: “el Señor se goza y se complace en ti, te ama y se alegra con júbilo como en día de fiesta”. El amor de Dios es más fuerte que nuestras debilidades y pecados; el amor de Dios salva a todos los que, con humildad, se acogen a él.

Estad siempre alegres en el Señor; se los repito, esten alegres. La razón que les da el apóstol a los primeros cristianos de la comunidad de Filipos para que estén alegres es la esperanza de que el Señor está cerca. Nosotros sabemos, como nos repiten frecuentemente los salmos, que el Señor siempre está cerca de los atribulados y de los que le invocan de corazón. Siempre vivimos en tiempo de salvación, nuestro ahora es un ahora de salvación, porque Dios siempre está viniendo, o queriendo venir, a nosotros. La alegría que nos recomienda san Pablo no es una alegría estruendosa, sino una alegría interior y bondadosa. Esta alegría interior y bondadosa es la que deben ver en los cristianos todas las personas con las que convivimos. Una alegría hecha de paz, de perdón, de amor y de verdad. Es “la paz de Dios, que debe custodiar nuestros corazones y nuestros pensamientos en Cristo Jesús”.

Proclamemos y vivamos la paz eso es parte de la justicia social. Busquemos el perdón a los demás a nosotros y con Dios, con la Iglesia.

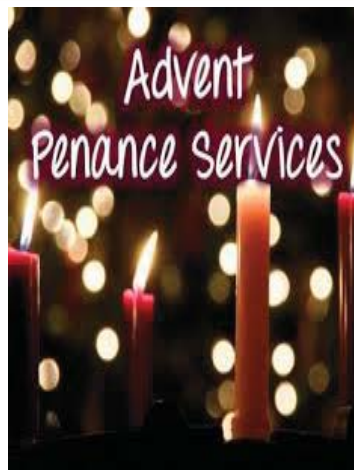

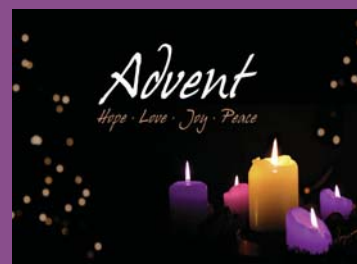
