

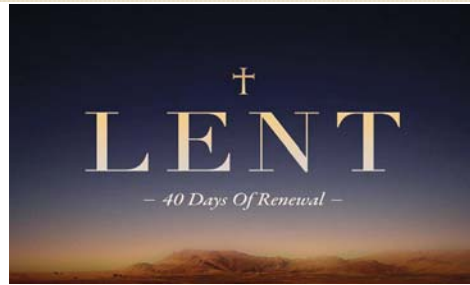

Lent is Coming! This year Lent begins with Ash Wednesday on March 1st. Lent has been observed by Christians since the

4th Century. It is a time of reflection, penitence and spiritual renewal before Easter. Lent ends at midnight on Holy Saturday, the night before Easter Sunday. During Lent some Christians focus on giving up something. Is it not absolutely necessary for the observation of Lent to give up a delicacy or a bad habit or an hour of sleep in the Lenten period, this should be a matter between a Christian and God. Some may decide to do something extra for their spiritual hindrance to the Spirit. Some may make a special sacrifice of some sort. And some may decide to improve their communication and fellowship with God by having special times of prayer throughout the day, or vow to worship in the church at every service held. The important thing is to make Lent a special time, a memorable time. A time so meaningful that it sets the tone for the rest of the entire year. ## ***HAY ALGO QUE NOS DISTINGA COMO SEGUIDORES DEL PROYECTO DE JESUS???***

Jesús nos habla de dos cosas difíciles y parecen como contrarias, el Amor a los demás y la Venganza. ¿Será esto algo imposible de vivir? El amor rompe la cadena del odio. La Ley del Tali3n fue puesta para evitar venganzas desmedidas. La venganza ser3a proporcional al da3o recibido. Jes3s, en cambio, propone el perd3n absoluto. Amor y perd3n, dos palabras claves en el mensaje de las lecturas de este domingo. F3ciles de pronunciar, pero dif3ciles de practicar. Amar a los que nos aman puede ser interesado. El m3rito est3 en amar a aqu3l que no nos puede devolver el amor, e incluso a aqu3l que nos odia. El Lev3tico advierte al pueblo para que deje a un lado el odio, el rencor y la venganza. Llega incluso a decir que cada uno debe “amar al pr3jimo como a uno mismo”. Jes3s no s3lo habla de amor al pr3jimo, tambi3n de amor al enemigo. ¿C3mo voy a amar a quien me hace da3o? ¿Pide Jes3s algo imposible de practicar?

Es cambiar la forma de ver las cosas, Amar tambi3n a los enemigos. ¿Por qu3 perdonar a nuestros enemigos? Porque Dios es el primero que nos perdona a nosotros, porque, como proclamamos en el salmo, “el Se3or es compasivo y misericordioso”. 3l no nos trata como merecen nuestros pecados y derrama raudales de misericordia con nosotros. A mi recuerdo viene aquella an3cdota en la que un ni3o, intrigado por las palabras de su catequista que le dec3a que Dios con su providencia infinita est3 siempre despierto velando por nosotros, le pregunt3 a Dios si no se aburr3a teniendo que estar todo el tiempo despierto. Dios le contest3 al ni3o con estas palabras: “no me aburro, me paso el d3a perdonando”. Contrasta la “ternura” de Dios con aquella imagen de Dios “eternamente enojado”, que me parece muy poco acorde con el Evangelio. ¿C3mo puedo llegar a amar a un enemigo? Miremos a Jes3s en la cruz. Dijo "Perd3nalos porque no saben lo que hacen". El amor al pr3jimo no reside en un acto de la voluntad, con el que intento reprimir todos mis sentimientos de odio, sino que se basa en una gracia: en que se me dan unos nuevos ojos para ver al pr3jimo.

Amor gratuito. Es la mirada de amor la que puede transformar el coraz3n de piedra del agresor. No cabe duda de que la violencia engendra violencia y esta rueda s3lo se puede parar con la fuerza del amor. Hay un lado “provocador” en las palabras de Jes3s en el Serm3n del Monte: pongan la otra mejilla, recen por los que los persiguen, amemos al enemigo, no juzguen y no ser3n juzgados. El amor puede hacer que el enemigo deje de ser enemigo y se convierta en un hermano, que reconozca su mal y trate de repararlo, que cambie de forma de pensar y de actuar. Es el amor: a diferencia de la justicia, y m3s all3 de la justicia, el amor es por esencia gratuito y no responde a ning3n derecho. No consiste, pues, en un intercambio: esto por aquello. Pues el amor s3lo puede revelarse sin equ3vocos cuando es amor al enemigo, ya que nada cabe esperar del enemigo. Esto no quiere decir, claro est3, que el amor consiste s3lo en amar a los enemigos; pero s3 quiere decir que el verdadero amor se manifiesta en el caso extremo de amar a los enemigos.

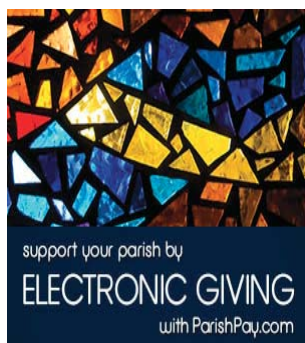
Al rezar hoy el Padrenuestro no seamos hip3critas. Seamos sinceros al decir “perdona nuestras ofensas como tambi3n nosotros perdonamos a los que nos ofenden”. Seamos comprensivos y compasivos como lo es Dios con nosotros. S3lo as3 nos daremos cuenta de que lo que parece imposible es posible. Amemos y perdonemos sobretodo y ante todo por nosotros no por los dem3s, eso me ayuda a m3. Paz y Bien.

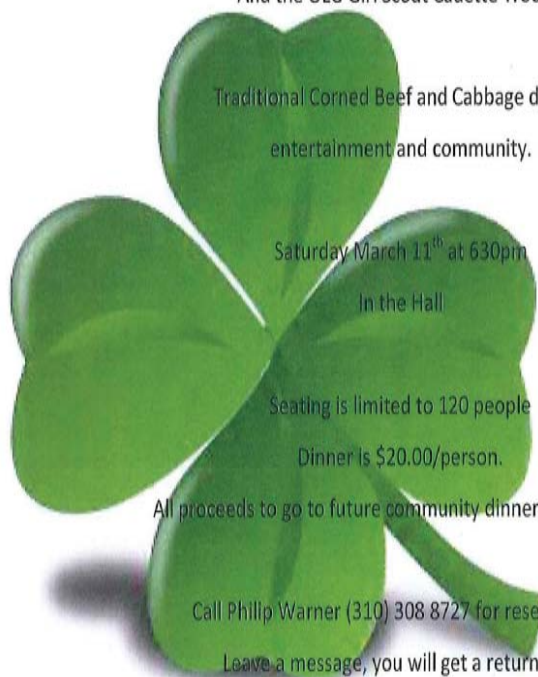

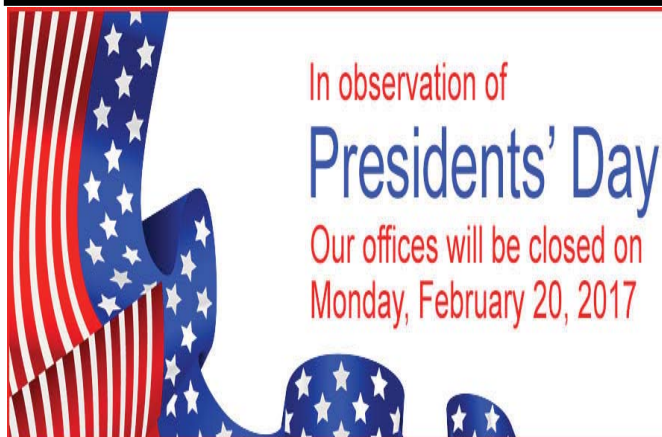
